Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary St Cecilia Saints Andrew Dung-Lac & Companions

Saint Cecilia is the patroness of musicians. It is written that as the musicians played at her wedding she "sang in her heart to the Lord". Her feast day is celebrated in the Latin Catholic, Eastern Catholic, Anglican, and Eastern Orthodox churches on November 22. She is one of seven women, excluding the Blessed Virgin, commemorated by name in the Canon of the Mass.



Reflection - The Victory of Love

On the cross Jesus endured insults and mockery. Yet his heart remained open, even to his enemies. He absorbed all the violence, transformed it,

And returned it as love and forgiveness, One's pain can so easily turn into rage, so that one wants only to lash out blindly at whoever happens to be within range.

From the depths, of his own pain, Jesus reached out to comfort the thief. Some people are like sugar cane: even when crushed in the mill, what they yield is sweetness. Jesus stretches our capacity for compassion. He challenges our idea of love. Each of us has a great capacity for love,. The pity is that it often goes unused. By our love people will know that we are followers of Christ the King.
